

WW2 MEMORIAL UNVEILING

A ceremony will be held on Saturday 16th July at 2pm at Norton War Memorial to unveil the name of LAC William Bullock. William had joined the army at the outbreak of war and was rescued from the beaches of Dunkirk, breaking a leg on being brought aboard the rescue ship. He then transferred to the RAF and was on a cross-country solo training flight from RAF Cranwell, he flew into bad weather, hitting a mast on Borough Hill, and crashing on the side of the hill in Norton Parish.

Attending the unveiling will be family members, including his half-brother from Canada, serving members of the RAF from Cranwell and Wittering, and RAF Association members. Everyone is invited to attend this service. Refreshments will be available in the village hall afterwards.

BROADBAND

ARE YOU IN OR OUT?

Or haven't you made your mind up yet? If you haven't then it might be worth you going to an EU Referendum Debate being held on June 2nd 7-8.30pm at the Icon Centre. Speaking in favour of remaining in, is Emma Reynolds MP and speaking in favour of leaving is our MP Chris Heaton-Harris. There will be an opportunity to ask questions after listening to the speakers present their opposing views.

DRONES

Drones have been used recently in the theft of lead from church roofs. They are becoming more and more popular. Do you know there are rules? The drone has to weigh less than 20kg. and not used for commercial purposes. You must avoid flying it within 150 mtrs of a congested area and 50 mtrs of a person, vessel, vehicle or structure not under the control of the pilot. It also needs to be flown within sight of the pilot. More information can be found on the CAA website. caa.co.uk

BROADBAND

No there is no good news about superfast broadband coming to the area, most properties get around 1 MB, and looking on the Northamptonshire website recently some parts of the village cannot get 3g or 4g either. Norton is not on the list for roll out of broadband which goes up to 2017. If you are desperate you may be considering satellite. If you go on to the superfast Northamptonshire web site, go to "get connected" and scroll down the right hand side you will find "Satellite Broadband Voucher Scheme" you may be able to claim a voucher for £350 to install Satellite Broadband.

BROADBAND AGAIN
