- 1) An email suggesting your house has been placed in an incorrect council tax band and request payment of an admin fee to be able to claim a refund
- 2) Incidents of cars being stopped and the driver being pulled from their car for it to be driven away.

Public Spaces Protection Order Enhanced Dog Control Powers

This came into force on 1st Dec 2015 which includes but is not limited to the following as an offence.

- 1) Failing to pick up after your dog and or have the means to do so if asked by an authorised officer
- 2) Failing to have dogs on a lead in a designated area
